Susanna started as a psychologist in paediatrics in 1979, continued in psychiatry with adults, then started a private practice as a therapist and organisational psychologist. Educational director in several of the educations for Swedish Society for Clinical Hypnosis.

Published two books, co-authored four books and written 20 articles on hypnosis and psychotherapy; clinical, scientific, existential, trauma, brain injury and communication.

Honorary member and past president of SSCH. Was clinical consultant for Sahlgrenska University Hospital in research on hypnosis and IBS. Practicing and teaching psychotherapy, hypnosis and neurological rehabilitation. Therapist for psychology students at Gothenburg University.

Supervising physicians, psychologists and clinical teams in Community Health Centres.
